The flag as an identity for the Nationalist Movement soon began to gain credence and the first widely accepted flag was the Vande Mataram Flag. This was designed after the partition of Bengal. It contained three strips of color, Green, Yellow and Red. The top green band had eight white lotuses to represent the eight provinces. The middle yellow band contained the phrase Vande Mataram in Hindi. The lower red band had a crescent at one end and a sun at the other end. Mostly, the early flags were religious in their symbolism....
