Hence the greatest distinction arises in the ratio of the muscles of the pelvis and trunk; for instance, the dorsal muscles are very large in the rabbit, and the quadratus lumborum and psoas muscles of that animal which lie anteriorly on the longest transverse processes. These muscles, on both sides, completely hide the anterior aspect of the bodies of the lumbar vertebrae. There is no iliacus muscle, as there is evidently no room for it; but the quadratus lumborum being left on the lateral and superior margin of the pelvis, it ascends above that, resting almost on the anterior and lateral margin of the...
