The Department of Health of the City of New York has regulations requiring a report every week concerning the existence of infectious diseases among those handling milk. The dairymen are required to report to the manager of the shipping station and he in turn notifies the health department. Even if these regulations were uniformly obeyed they would not protect against bacilli carriers. (See Appendix D.) Temperature standard. New York, Boston, and other cities require that milk be immediately cooled to 50F. or below, and that it shall not exceed this temperature before delivery. The requirement is desirable, and does not necessitate complicated methods of examination. This regulation very properly necessitates the use of ice at the producing farm, and the use of refrigerator cars where the milk is transported long distances. Its strict enforcement tends to eliminate the sale of milk from...
