He states his main assumption in the following words: My thesis is, that according to Aeschylus, the action of the Eumenides closes only a few days (perhaps ten) after the Agamemnon. He thus makes the first two plays almost continuous in action. Professor Seymour's ideas have been accepted and championed by Professor Louis Dyer.
