The younger generation has to fight for equality, too. The Texas Mexican boys playing high school football in Klail City didn't get letter jackets, even though all of their Anglo peers did. And when the Mexican boys weren't interested in hustling for the ball the following year, the school board came up with enough money for all the eligible players to get letter jackets.
