How to suffer such silence What feelings does mutism create in others, and what is it trying to tell us Working without the verbal feedback of the client demands a great deal of perseverance and attentiveness on the part of the therapist to ensure that the dialogue with the child remains intact. This volume emphasises the ability to stage games with the mute child as well as the importance of triads, of mental imagination and the ability to play for the development of communication and socialisation skills in the child. The results of the latest research in educational and developmental psychology are applied.
