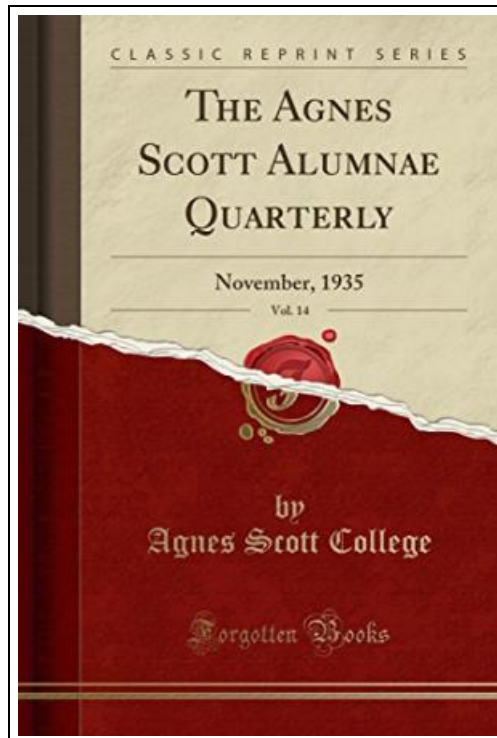

During the active parts of his life, he played a distinguished part in the political and civic life of the state. He served with great ability many terms in both the house and the senate, was chairman of the Georgia State Railroad Commission, the author of a number of important state laws and was recognized as an authority on taxation and State railroad ownership.
