Excerpt from The Dedication of the Germanic Museum of Harvard University To the President of the University: - Sir, - The collections of the Germanic Museum, as far as they were installed during the academic year 1902-03, may be summed up as follows: - The industrial activity of Germanic tribes previous to the establishment of the Karolingian empire is represented by a few isolated objects, such as a grave-urn of the fifth century from the island of F hr, a model of the Nydam boat from the Museum of Germanic Antiquities at Kiel, a figure of a Frankish warrior of the seventh century, with exact reproductions of arms and implements, from the Roman-Germanic Museum at Mainz. The bulk of the collection is devoted to German art in the narrower sense, particularly to German architecture and sculpture of the Middle Ages and the Renaissance. The background of this part of the Museum is formed by 150 large photographs from the Koniglich Preussische Messbildanstalt at Berlin, covering the walls of the lower aisle of the building, and containing views...
