Do not use a Lembert suture with the button; it is useless; it is unnecessary to abrade the peritoneum. As the most common cause of obstruction of the pylorus is cancer, which without excision necessarily terminates fatally, the operation of gastroenterostomy is for temporary relief--and while patients may stand the immediate effects of the operation, after four or five days they are apt to become weaker and weaker, until they finally succumb to the general depression to which has been added the depressing effect of the operation. The abdominal wound was closed by silk worm sutures. A peculiarity noticed was the thickness and rigidity of the peritoneum, it being impossible to bring the edges of the peritoneum in opposition. An antiseptic dressing was applied and the patient put to bed. His pulse was better after the operation than before. Temperature...
