

Improvements Noted.—Shingle roofs of some houses for paupers repaired, some painting and whitewashing. Superintendent s house repaired, rooms ceiled and some painting done. Recommendations.—Drive a pump at least 30 feet deep at the paupers quarters. Replace surface closets with fly-proof privies of the wet type. Cook the food for white inmates in the almshouse kitchen and let them eat their meals in the room adjoining the negro s dining room. Pickens Almshouse. Visited November 30, 1916. Located about 2 miles from Pickens on Canebrake road. Mr. W. Taylor Stewart, Superintendent. Farm and Buildings.—There are about 200 acres in the almshouse farm. Buildings, especially inmates quarters, in poor repair. The superintendent s house is a two-story frame structure. The white inmates live in a four-room frame cottage. There is a two-room frame house for negroes, unoccupied when inspected. Good barn. Open fireplaces. Kerosene lights. Wash basin in each occupied room. Three or four galvanized tubs. Wooden beds with straw ticks, one or two feather ticks, quilts, sheets, few blankets, and pillows. Condition of bedding only fair. Two surface closets, bad repair...
