The leading features of this plan are the establishment of a board to arrange, control and supervise examinations, to test the preparation of those who design to enter upon the special or exclusive practice of ophthalmology. This board is also to fix the requirements to be met by all candidates for examination. These requirements shall include graduation from a medical college of recognized good standing, at least two years before the examination; and such subsequent study of ophthalmology as may be required by the board. The board is also authorized to prepare lists of medical schools, hospitals and private instructors recognized...
