It has also undertaken the specific function of preparing plans for the protection of materials of cultural, scientific, or historic importance in the possession of agencies of the Federal Government. In its relations with State, local, and private custodians of cultural materials, the Committee functions principally through State committees on conservation of cultural resources, which have been established in almost every State. The present handbook is based on a preliminary discussion of the conservation of cultural resources in time of war prepared by Richard H. Heindel, formerly Executive Secretary of the Committee on...
