S. -PRC Joint Communiqus of 1972, 1979, and 1982; and the Six Assurances of 1982. For decades, Taiwan has been of significant security, economic, and political interest to the United States. In 2013, Taiwan was the 12th-largest U. S. trading partner. Ties or tension across the Taiwan Strait affect international security (with potential U. S. intervention). While the United States does not diplomatically recognize Taiwan, it is an important autonomous actor. Today, 22 countries have diplomatic relations with Taiwan as the ROC. Taiwans 23 million people enjoy self-governance with democratic elections. Democracy has offered Taiwans people a greater say in their status,...
