KenKen (also known as KENKEN, KenDoku, CalcuDoku, Square Wisdom) is a mathematical and logical puzzle loosely similar to Sudoku. It was invented by a Japanese mathematics teacher Tetsuya Miyamoto. The objective is to fill the grid in with the digits 1 through N (where N is the number of rows or columns in the grid) such that: Each row contains exactly one of each digit. Each column contains exactly one of each digit. Each bold-outlined group of cells (block) contains digits which achieve the specified result using the specified mathematical operation: addition (+), subtraction (-), multiplication (x), and division (/). Unlike Killer Sudoku, digits may repeat within a block. This item ships from La Vergne, TN. Paperback.
