




Flower Loom Crochet: Create 8 Beautiful Accessories Combining Crochet with a Flower Loom (Paperback)

Flower loomed motifs usually have very little embroidery on them, often only a small amount which holds the webbing together in the centre. Occasionally more embroidery, pom-poms or buttons or other embellishments are used to decorate the centre. Learn to make 5 flower motifs using the Clover Flower Loom. Basic written instructions along with colour illustrations are included to guide you through winding, darning and making decorative stitches for each flower. Once you ve mastered the flowers, the authors have included 5 beautiful accessory designs each of which include 1 or 2 of the 5 flower motifs. The book opens with some excellent instructions on loom use, illustrated with some clear diagrams on how to put it together and use the various looms, finishing off, darning and more. This is a useful, well produced booklet and a good reason to invest in a Clover loom.
