Excerpt from Tomato Diseases The grower must realize that a good many of the troubles affecting tomatoes, such as leaf spot, leaf mould, mosaic, wilts etc., may be started in, and spread from, the seed-bed. This means that special care should be taken to protect the small seedlings from becoming infected. TO this end the disinfected seed should be sown in clean or sterilized soil, which should be kept free from weeds. The seed should not be sown too densely, as a crowded seed-bed is more subject to damping-off. Also since a continuous damp surface in the seed-bed is favourable to damping-off it is good practice to have the soil Of the seed-bed covered with alight layer Of sand, so as to ensure a more rapid drying Of the surface soil. Preferably, seedlings should be grown under glass so that on successive cloudy, humid days the excess humidity may be more readily driven off by heat and proper ventilation. This is particularly applicable to the seed lings for the fall greenhouse crop, which are so Often severely attacked by the leaf mould fungus....
