Ed did both, first as a vaudeville and Ziegfeld Follies star, then as the Perfect Fool (so named from one of his many selfproduced Broadway revues), as radio s Fire Chief on the popular Texaco-sponsored program, and as an early pioneer at the dawn of network television. He attained a level of praise and respect from his comedy peers, critics, and, of course, the public, rarely matched by any other comedian since. In his later years, he became a highly acclaimed dramatic character actor, much to the surprise and joy of all who didn t know he had it in him (including Ed himself). Yet for all his impressive achievements, this comedian/actor/director/writer has been too often overlooked in the years since his death...
