Between these anchors, which are hung on the base of the rail while the concrete is being placed, standard track spikes (5V2 X 9-16) are spaced two feet apart on alternate sides of the base of the rails. Tie rods (1 XWX5) with a 3 thread on each end, are spaced every six feet. Plate V. shows the tracks at the intersection of Congress Avenue and Sixth Street. The substructure employed on the Avenue is shown in Plate VI. This gives a view of the rails on temporary supports awaiting the filling in of the concrete substructure by the crew just beyond.
