




Free-Spinning and Tumbling Tests of a 116-Scale Model of the McDonnell XP-85 Airplane

In general, full reversal of the rudder pedals did not stop the spinning rotation. To make the model satisfactorily meet-the spin-recovery requirements it was found that installation of either a very large ventral fin (I7. 9 square feet, full scale) below the tail or a somewhat smaller ventral fin and rudder (12. 4 square feet, total . full-scale area) with a rudder throw of at least -22deg was required. Either a 21. 3-foot tail parachute or a 6. 4-foot wing-tip parachute (drag coefficient approximately 0. 70) appears necessary as an emergency spin-recovery device during demonstration spins.
