In addition, there are illustrated accounts for more than 100 Casual and Accidental birds, along with an appendix listing records for 55 western rarities. National Geographic has packed this guide with a number of new and unique features that set it apart from the existing, a Visual Index, printed on the inside front and back covers, which lets readers access the content visually. This feature will be especially helpful to the beginning-and-intermediate birding audience. It also features: extensively annotated art, which highlights the birds' key physical features, facilitating identification; identification tip boxes, which help with the most challenging identifications; thumbtabs, to help readers find information fast; 600 (est) new range maps and 70 new art figures; and, durable cover and quick-reference flaps that double as placemarkers.
