

It is a European plant. Horned Poppies are low-growing and are good to use as a border or edging plant. Luteum grows from one to two feet tall. The leaves are hairy. The flowers usually solitary, are large, yellow or orange, and rather short-lived. But the plants bloom constantly, and as the foliage is good, too, they are used for these reasons. Choose an open, sunny place with good garden soil for the Horned Poppies. They may be raised from the seed or by division of old plants. Start the seeds indoors in February.
