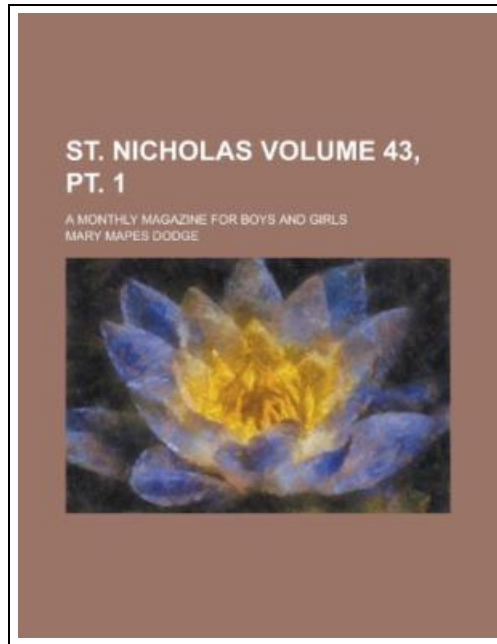

They made a gay cavalcade, galloping along the roads leading from the Old Dominion to New Englands thriving capital. Two days after leaving Alexandria, they reached Philadelphia, where they remained a week, enjoying the official and social attentions that made the City of Brotherly Love the most attractive in the colonies.
