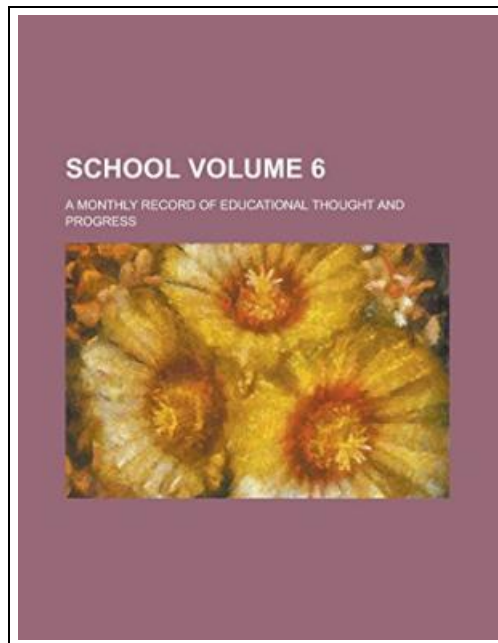

The story which has won high honours in France is entertaining, and it is only one of the many features of this useful book. The editor has contributed a short introduction, valuable notes, a list of irregular verbs, a vocabulary, words and phrases for viva voce drill, sentences on syntax and idioms for viva voce practice and passages for translation into French.
