




White and Alone in Baby Doc s Haiti: Parts 11, 12 and 13 of My Very Long Youth (Paperback)

Bohme, who travels on a British Passport but describes himself as a Eurican, was born in London in 1942 under Hitler's rockets to a footloose refugee from Berlin and a highly romantic English rose.
