

Excerpt from Proceedings of the Mining and Metallurgical Society of America, Vol. 5 Ballot of Dec. 8, 191 x.-For the counting of the ballots issued under date of Dec. 8, 1911, F. W. Parsons and J. T. Beard were appointed as tellers. They counted the ballots on Jan. 8, 1912, in conformity with the provisions of the by-laws and reported as follows: J. Parke Channing, President. Sir: We beg to inform you that we have this day canvassed the ballot of Dec. 8, 1911. The Secretary of the Society delivered to us a checked list of members showing a total of 229, of whom 218 were eligible to vote, and together therewith delivered 107 ballots received from members eligible to vote, which ballots had been carefully checked off on the list of members. Of the 107 ballots delivered two were rejected because of absence of signature. The canvass of the remaining 105 ballots was as follows: Question I.-The Memorial to the President of the United States. Shall this memorial be adopted by the Society? There were 96 votes...
