




Sonny's Dream: A story which teaches children how to conquer their fears. (Young Spirit Books)

Fearful memories of his young cubhood make him reluctant to learn to fish. ("Goggle-eyed Monster Fish stared at me. Reflected light on their sharp glaring teeth made me dazed and dizzy.") His mother explains that he fell into a stream with salmon, but now he is bigger and must perfect his skills. She also tells him, "Sonny, now, to be an adult Grizzly, you have one big lesson to learn. Without my help, you will make a decision on your own." Senshu's misty illustrations clearly reflect her love of her native Alaska, but the accompanying misty text will appeal neither to preschoolers wanting bear stories nor to young naturalists wanting facts.
