The book argues that Hardy had a more detailed and acute understanding of the importance of dress in forming and regulating personal identity and social relations than any other writer of his time. Structured thematically, it takes into account both nineteenth-century and modern theoretical approaches to the significance of what we wear. The author gives an extended analysis of individual works by Hardy, showing, for example, that "A Pair of Blue Eyes" is central to the study of the function of clothing in the expression and perception of sexuality. "The Hand of Ethelberta", "The Mayor of Casterbridge", "Tess of the d'Urbervilles" and "The Woodlanders" are examined in order to show the extent to which dress obscures or reveals the nature of the self. Hardy's other novels, as well as the short stories and poems, are used to confirm the centrality of dress and clothing in Hardy's work. The book also raises issues such as the...



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
