In the report for the year 1902 the subjects of the consolidation of rural schools and manual training in the rural schools were presented, also, as the legislature had passed a law permitting the transportation of pupils to and from school, a clear statement was made of the proper procedure for school districts in the consideration of the subject of con solidation.
