The author skilfully interweaves narrative threads linking the present to the past through fact and fiction. Prompted by the sparse evidence of names and dates inscribed in an heirloom bible, research mingles with speculation to reveal secrets and moral dilemmas of life in the Georgian era. The story will strike a chord with anyone intrigued by documentary sources, and by the benefits and limitations of the Internet as a means of uncovering the whole...
